

Anna Wible Berkstresser

Mrs. Anna Wible Berkstresser, 75, Harrisonville, died at 4:00 A.M. Monday morning, February 16, 1976, at the Fulton County Medical Center. She had been a guest at Decker's home for four years.

Born February 4, 1901, she was the daughter of the late William Harry and Maude Bailey Woodall. She was a member of the Fairview United Methodist Church. She taught an adult women's Sunday School class for a number of years. She taught in the elementary schools in the Fulton County area for 33 years and was a member of the Retired Teachers Association and a former member of the NEA and PSEA.
