

Randolph E. Fagley

Randolph E. Fagley of Three Springs, RD 1, died at the home of his son, LeRoy Fagley, on Sunday afternoon, February 23, 1964, at 2:35 o'clock. He had been ill for four months.

Born in Fulton county on September 7, 1879, he was the son of William H. and Mary A. (Farner) Fagley. He married Sadie Catherine Barber on September 6, 1905. She preceded him in death in 1924.
