

Mrs. William F. Hixson

Mrs. Cora Dell (Duvall) Hixson, wife of William F. Hixson, of Brush Creek township, Fulton county, died Monday afternoon, April 24, 1939, of a heart ailment, being found in bed by her daughter, Naomi. She had been ailing for many years.

She was aged 51 years, 9 months and 16 days and was the eldest daughter of William H. and Mollie (Hanks) Duvall, both deceased. She was born at Akersville. She was united in marriage with William Francis Hixson at Bedford on April 11, 1906, and resided at their home near Akersville all her life with the exception of two years in Ohio.

Surviving to mourn her loss are her husband, five sons and two daughters, Archie, of New Gallilee; Guy, of Breezewood; Foster and Vernon of Everett; Ruth (Mrs. Webster Fischer), of Amaranth; Naomi and Vaughn, at home; also four brothers and one sister, Rev. Lewis A. Duvall, of Crystal Springs; Rev. Arthur Duvall, of Canfield, Ohio; Howard Duvall, of Gary, Indiana, and Rev. Ira Duvall, of Altoona; -Mrs. Carl Weist, of Everett R. D. 2; and four grandsons and three granddaughters. An aged aunt, Mrs. Lib Foor, who has been making her home with her for nearly three years, and three uncles, Amos Duvall, of Crystal Springs; John L. Duvall of Wells Tannery, and George A. Duvall, of Williamsport, also survive.

She was preceded in death by two sons, two daughters, two brothers and one sister. Mrs. Hixson was a faithful member of the Akersville Methodist church. She was a loving and faithful wife, a patient and untiring mother, and always gave assistance to all she could. She was carried to her last resting place by her five sons and one son-in-law.
