

## REUBEN H. HULL

Reuben H. Hull, an aged citizen of Fulton county, died, March 24th, 1934 at the home of McCauley Pittman where he had been making his home since the death of his wife, Mrs. Emma Hull, 15 years ago.

Mr. Hull was born in Franklin county, May 10, 1856, hence was aged 77 years, 10 months and 14 days. He was a son of Mr. and Mrs. William Hull, who preceded him in death many years previous.

Mr. Hull became a member of the Laurel Ridge Christian church and afterwards retained this membership until death called him. He was a faithful christian as many who witnessed his six long weeks of painful suffering from senile gangrene will know. Several times he was heard praying to his kind Master, alone and once during his illness he looked into the face of Mrs. Pittman and made the statement of any christian man: "I am ready to go".

Mr. Hull leaves to mourn his passing, the following two brothers, Grant R. Hull of Martinsburg, W. Va.; Otis Hull, of Hedgesville, W. Va.; one sister, Elizabeth Hull, deceased; two half brothers, Harvey Cole and Newton Cole, of Hagerstown, Md.

The loss of his kind face and deeds will be missed by many, for he was a kind neighbor and friend in time of need.

Interment was made in Mt. Zion M. E. church yard. March 26th. Services were conducted by Rev. Charles Meade of Warfordsburg.
