

Oscar W. Ranck, 62 of Hustontown, died in the Bedford County Memorial Hospital on Friday, October 24, at 8:30 A. M., from injuries he received in an accident the preceding Wednesday at 5:20 A. M., eight miles east of Harrisonville on Route 30.

Oscar William Ranck was born on September 5, 1907, at Hustontown, a son of William H. and Maye V. (Laidig) Ranck. He was united in marriage on June 2, 1928, to Veda M. Heefner, who survives.

Also surviving are one son, Robert W. Ranck, of Fayetteville, and three brothers, Edgar J. Ranck, of Renovo; Marshall E. Ranck, of Mount Union, and Samuel G. Ranck, of Hustontown. He was preceded in death by one sister. Also surviving are five grandchildren.

Mr. Ranck was a member of the Hustontown United Methodist Church and the Hustontown Area Volunteer Fire Company. He was engaged in construction work during his lifetime and also served as a state inspector for several years. He spent his entire life in the Hustontown area.

Funeral services were held on Monday, October 27, at 10:30 A. M., from the House Funeral Chapel, the Rev. Bruce Bardine officiating. Interment was made in the Hustontown Methodist Cemetery.
