

IRA W. ZIMMERMAN

Ira Wilson Zimmerman, a well known citizen of Thompson township, died at his home there on Tuesday, March 12, 1935 from liver and gall bladder trouble, after three weeks confinement to his bed. He was a son of Jacob and Amy Zimmerman and was born in Thompson township, October 14, 1860, being aged 74 years, 4 months and 28 days.

Mr. Zimmerman is survived by his wife, who was Lillie May Carl, and the following children: Jacob Harris, of Aurora, Ill., Ernest, of Chambersburg, Amy, wife of Dennis Seburn, at home, Ira Lee, of Aurora Ill. Helen, at home, Etta May, wife of Herman Zimmerman, of Sylvan, Pa., and the following brothers and sisters: Elizabeth Palmer, of Warfordsburg, Anna Malinda Philips, of Mercersburg, Jennie Belle Decker, of Bedford, Cephas Howard Zimmerman, of Hancock, Md.

Mr. Zimmerman was a member of the Rehobeth M. E. Church, one of the two surviving charter members of Warfordsburg I. O. O. F., Franklin Ranck being the other survivor, being a member of that organization for 50 years, also a member of the Jr. O. U. A. Mechanics at Big Pool, Md. He was also superintendent of Sunday school.

Funeral services will be held at the Little Cove Zion Lutheran Church, Friday, March 15 at 2:30 P. M., his pastor Rev. Auld of the Warfordsburg M. E. Church in charge.
